Data is both the solution and the problem; critically essential and challenging to get right¹

DATA, DATA EVERYWHERE ...

- Examples of data as inputs utilized by performance teams
 - Securities and their characteristics (country, sector/industry, other factors)
 - Positions owned
 - Transactions (buys/sells, contributions/withdrawals, and corporate actions)
 - Valuations/Pricing

 \rightarrow Impacts from "upstream" groups responsible for these activities

- Examples of data as outputs from performance teams
 - Performance
 - Attribution
 - Returns-based risk statistics
 - Holdings-based portfolio characteristics

 \rightarrow Quality controls and processes conducted by performance teams

DATA MANAGEMENT: WHAT IS IT

- Data management as a noun
 - Departmental function with a team structure and governance
- Data management as a verb
 - Activity which is undertaken by individuals
- Data management as an expletive
 - Something perpetually causing problems and frustrations

TSG / PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT FORUM DATA QUALITY WORKING GROUP

- Focus was on challenges that inherently exist, and how to manage/mitigate them from a quality and accuracy perspective
 - → Primary observations included the fact most errors in performance-related output are due to data quality, rather than errors in the calculations themselves
 - → Various recommendations were offered for validating data and limiting the risk of having them impact outputs
 - → Which cause your team and/or your firm the most challenges?
